Occupational Hygiene In OSH law

Business owner shall have the person holding the qualification and evaluate the working environment where hazardous work to the worker's health is being carried.

- Qualification
- Occupational hygienist certified by Korean government

Occupational Hygiene In OSH law

- Business owner may conduct the exposure monitoring by entrusting it to an exposure monitoring Institution designated by Minister of Labor
- Criteria of designation (manpower)
- Two Occupational Hygienist (at least one professional grade)
- One Analyst (at least 1 person)
- No. of occupational hygienists is different according to No. of workplaces that the monitoring institute wants to evaluate.

Criteria of Application for Occupational Hygienist

Professional grade (similar to CIH)

- Bachelor's degree plus 7 years suitable experience
- Equivalent to scholarship and experience
- Engineer grade
- Bachelor's degree
- 2-year college graduate plus 2 years suitable experience

Quality Control of Exposure Monitoring Results

Anyone who is conducting an exposure monitoring by OSH law shall participate quality control program and must pass all the test according to the program
2 times a year (every 6 months)
KOSHA is managing the program under

the authority of OSH law

Qualification

Regular member:

.....

- A four-year college graduate shall agree on the purpose of the society and work within the field of occupational hygiene,
- A two-year college graduate shall be engaged in the field of practical affairs for more than two years and agree on the purpose of the society



Student member:

.....

 An undergraduate majoring in a field related to occupational hygiene shall agree on the purpose of the society.

Group member:

A department or a group belonging to an occupational hygiene-related agency or incorporation shall agree on the purpose of the society.



To achieve the purpose, the society shall conduct the following projects

- Hosting academic lecture meetings, seminars, and conferences related to occupational hygiene
- Publishing journals and other publications

Performing plans related to member's welfare





 Educating, training, and studying occupational hygiene

- Performing projects on occupational hygiene as entrusted by the government and public agencies
- Performing projects to achieve the purpose of the society

Rights and Duties of a Member



A member shall have the following rights and duties.

- Right to be involved in all projects according to the foundation's purpose;
- Duty to comply with the articles of incorporation, by-laws and resolutions of regular meetings
- Duty to pay the membership fee (does not apply to a student member).



.

A member shall be disqualified according to the decision of the Board of Directors and the General Meeting

- Severely libels against the society and is considered to have critical effects;
- Violates any decision made by the General Meeting and Board of Directors
- Voluntarily withdraws of membership
